

Title: Financial Journalism Intern

Description and Responsibilities

Student will:

- Research, write and edit articles based on financial data and reports on market outlook.
- Be part of a team that will create a financial document on client financial data and forecasts.
- Learn how to interpret complex financial data and translate terms into easier to read formats.
- Use graphic design software like InDesign and Illustrator to format and layout document.
- Learn about financial industry institutional investing.

Qualifications

- Must be a Junior/Senior.
- Must have reliable transportation.
- Washington State law requires all applicants to be 16 years of age or older.
- Must be able to or willing to pass a Federal Background Check.
- Must complete designated learning objectives set forth by employer and CSD WBL program.
- Students are encouraged to take a 6th period exit but not required to do so.

Anticipated Work Schedule and Other Job Specifications:

- Student must have flexible, before/after school schedule to complete 90 hour requirement. (Schedules will created based on what works best for intern and mentor) February 23-June 21 (2017)
- Student interviews February 15-February 22 (2017)
- Internship conclusion June21 (2017).
