Dear Papermaker Family,

Prom is fast approaching! Nineteen years later, I still remember my Senior Prom at El Camino High School in Oceanside, CA. The bad hair, uncomfortable tuxedo, and over-priced dinner were all part of the experience, yet the memory will last a lifetime. That is our primary focus — to create a safe and positive environment for all of our students so they can create those memories. Our DJ last year said that it was the most respectful and well-behaved Prom he had ever worked. AND the kids had a blast! That is a testament to our amazing kids and wonderful families.

There is always a concern at such functions about consumption of alcoholic beverages and use of drugs. We do not allow students into the Prom when it has been detected that they are under the influence. Police and parents will be contacted should this occur. Our major concern is for the safety of our students, and we would not want to experience the sadness and needless loss of lives. Students will be held accountable for their behavior as it relates to school policy. Please emphasize this with your student. We want them to have a great time and make memories, but we will not sacrifice their safety to accomplish that.

Here are some important details:

- 1. The Prom will be held on Saturday, April 13th, 2019 from 8:00-11:00 p.m., at Left Bank Annex in Portland.
- 2. Tickets go on sale between
 - March 25th April 5th for \$20 per ticket
 - April 8th April 11th = \$25 per ticket
- 3. Dance passes are required for ALL students because the dance is out of state. On the same pass is information necessary for students who want to bring a guest (non-CHS student). No more than one high school guest per CHS student. Guest passes are available in the 800 Admin Office, Commons Areas, the ASB window and online on our CHS website. Dance passes are due no later than the end of the day on April 10th. It is important that the guest and CHS student read the entire guest pass form and fill it out completely. By signing the Dance pass, they commit to abiding by all school and district policies.
- 4. Tuxedos and formal gowns are not required. However, students are asked to dress appropriately for this semi-formal occasion (collared shirts, dress pants, skirts, dresses, etc.) and follow CHS dress code.
- 5. The school provides chaperones. School staff and parents supervise the dance.
- 6. This is a school-sponsored activity so all school rules apply at this function. Refer to Student/Parent Handbook for details. Students are subject to search if there is a reasonable suspicion to warrant a search.
- 7. The school is not responsible for students in transit to or from the dance.
