Our Lady Papermakers scored 45 points to place 3rd overall in the STATE 4A Track and Field Championships this weekend! The ladies had two STATE CHAMPIONS – Nikki Corbett in the Discus who also placed 6th in the Shot Put; Caleigh Lofstead in the Pole Vault with a new STATE RECORD vault of 12-7! Alissa Pudlitzke placed 8th in the 1600m and 4th in the 3200m; Her team-mate Emma Jenkins placed 5th in the 3200m; Jordan Davis took home a 4th in both the 100m and 300m hurdles. Our Girls 4 x 200m relay (Murata, Quade, Gray, Davis) placed 8th overall with a new school record time.

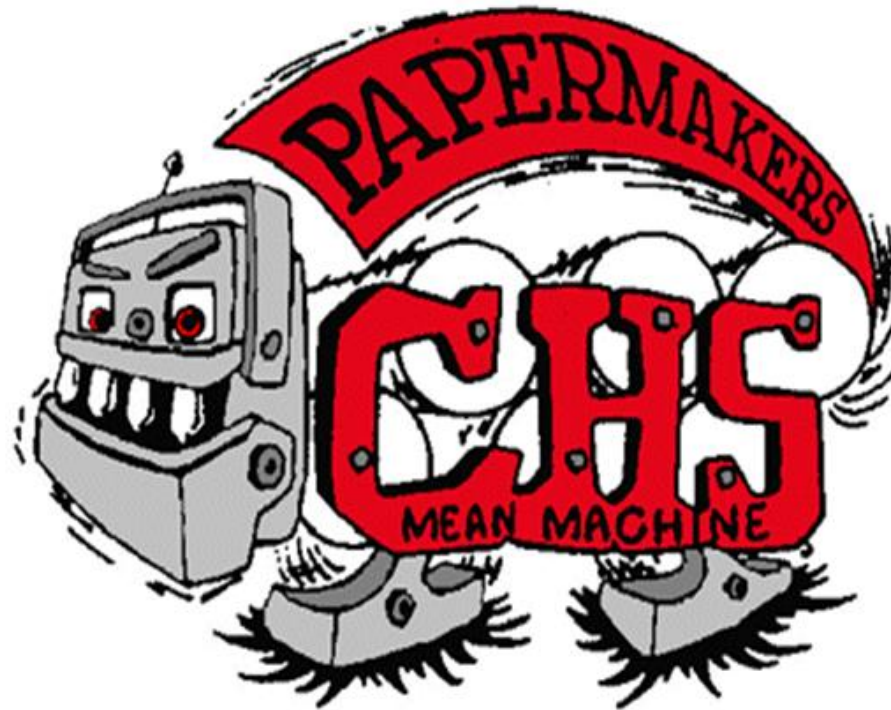
