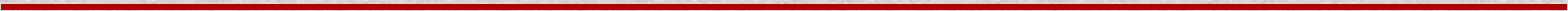

[2 years of the same language] | • 2.0 |

Many colleges look for students who have earned a strong G. P. A., have above average SAT scores, and who have taken academic classes for electives, in order to be accepted. Involvement in activities, athletics, clubs, leadership, and community service may also influence admissions.

Some Additional Programs

- **Cascadia Tech Academy (Skills Center)**

Half-day programs for Juniors and Seniors interested in learning a trade. - **Cornerstone - College in the High School**

CHS students may earn college credit for the following classes by signing up and paying \$55/credit instead of \$507: Body Works, English 11 (CWU 101 and 102), Military History, Pre-Calculus and Acc. Pre-Calc (CWU Math 153/154)
