## **CAMAS HIGH SCHOOL** SUMMER SCHOOL STUDENT APPLICATION **Summer 2017**

CHS Summer school is for CSD students only based on the following options:

1) Brief Credit Recovery for students who were close to passing (at 50% or more) and need to complete additional work to bring their grade up to passing (D).

2) Semester Course Recovery for students needing to repeat an Algebra I or a Geometry class they failed or received less than the C- grade needed to move on the next level of Math.

3) Washington State History for students who have not met this graduation requirement in Middle School or are new to the State.

1) Brief Credit Recovery (fee - \$130.00 per semester class) - This program is available to any student who failed a class and has the teacher's approval for Credit Recovery participation. The typical student who qualifies for this program will have had reasonable attendance and have been close to passing (no less than 50%). The teacher feels that the student could earn a "D" with the completion of a little more required work. The student must complete work by the end of summer school and may finish early. Summer School times are 8AM-12Noon for Brief Credit Recovery and the dates are: June 27, 28, 29, 30, and July 5, 6, 7, 10, 11, 12, 13, and 14.

2) Algebra I or Geometry Course Recovery (Fee - \$180.00 per semester class) – With teacher approval students may repeat up to two one-semester classes that they have failed or in which they have received less than the C- grade needed to move on the next level of Math. Class selection is limited to Algebra I or Geometry. Summer School times are 8AM-12Noon for Algebra I and 12Noon - 4PM for Geometry and the dates are: Semester One—June 27- July 14 and Semester Two--July 17 – August 4.

3) Washington State History (Fee-\$65.00) – With counselor approval, students may pick up a packet on the first day of summer school. June 27<sup>th</sup>, and return it completed by July 14<sup>th</sup> at 10:00 AM.

Summer School Rules

- Parents may pre-excuse up to 3 student absences providing that staff will be available upon a  $\checkmark$ student's return and the absence has no significant impact upon the student's progress.
- $\checkmark$ Students with more than 3 absences, excused or unexcused, will be dismissed from the program. Three tardies equals one absence.
- Students with behavioral problems will be dismissed from the program.  $\checkmark$
- All fees are due upon enrollment the first day. 1
